

DISAPPEARING 9-PATCH

Instructions for different sizes are written Throw (Twin, Queen).

Throw size 66" x 66":

1 1/4 Fabric A & B
1/3 yard Fabric C
5/8 yards inner border
1 3/8 yards outer border
5/8 yards binding

Twin size 66" x 88":

2 Fabric A & B
5/8 yard Fabric C
2/3 yards inner border
1 1/4 yards outer border
2/3 yards binding

Queen size 88"x105:

3 5/8 yards Fabrics A & B
1 1/4 yards Fabric C
7/8 yards Inner border
1 1/2 yards Outer border
7/8 yards Binding

Finished Block size: 13 1/2"

Cut fabric A 8 (12, 20) strips 5" wide

Cut fabric B 8 (12, 20) strips 5" wide

Cut fabric C 2 (3, 6) strips 5" wide

Sew strips along side each other to make 6 separate strips sets in the following combinations: make 4 (6, 12) sets of A / B / A ; make 2 sets of B / C / B

Cut across the strip sets at 5" to make a total of 32 (48, 96) patch-sets of A / B / A ; and 16 (24, 42*) patch-sets of B / C / B

Making 9-Patch blocks

Sew rows of A / B / A , B / C / B, and A / B / A to make a 9 patch block. Make a total of 16 (24, 42*) blocks.

Quartering the blocks

Measure 7" vertically from one side of the 9 patch block (should be vertical center) and cut down the center of the block going through all 3 squares of the 9-patch. DO NOT MOVE CUT BLOCKS.

Measure horizontally from the bottom of the block 7" (should be horizontal center) and cut across the center of the block going through all 3 squares of the 9-patch. DO NOT MOVE CUT BLOCKS.

Assembling the blocks

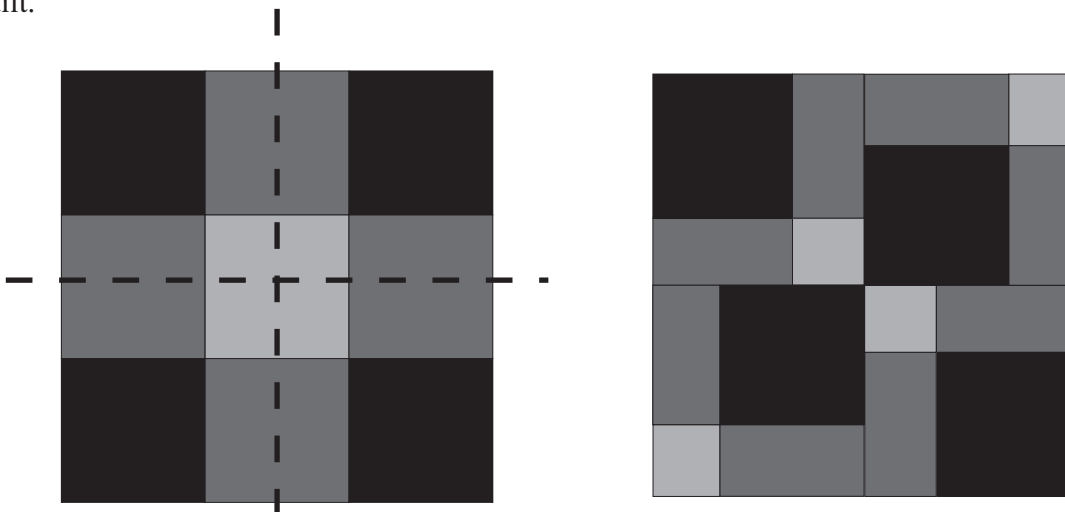
Rotate blocks at top right and bottom left so the large squares are in at the center position and the small are at the outside corners (180 degrees).

Sew blocks back together in this position to complete the "Disappearing 9-Patch" block. Make 16 (24, 42) blocks.

Sew blocks into 4 (6, 7) rows of 4 (4, 6) blocks each, then sew the rows together to form the quilt top.

Measure quilt and cut 6 (7, 9) solid border strips 2 1/2" wide, sew end to end, and attach to the 4 sides of the quilt.

Measure quilt and cut 7(8, 10) striped print outer border strips 5 1/2" wide, sew end to end, and attach to the 4 sides of the quilt.
